## Licensing Notes

### pCOS Use Cases and Features

There are many application scenarios for the PDF Information Retrieval Tool PDFlib pCOS within PDF workflows, but you can also use PDFlib pCOS as a tool for learning or debugging PDF. Here are some typical situations:

- ▶ check incoming documents for predefined criteria
- ▶ identify problem files in a large collection
- ▶ create metadata summaries for document management
- ▶ quality assurance before publishing documents
- ▶ document retrieval and repository workflows
- ▶ summarize the bookmarks
- ▶ extract components of PDF documents, e.g. ICC profiles

With PDFlib pCOS you can retrieve PDF metadata, hypertext, and other components from a PDF document. All objects outside the actual page content can be retrieved with a simple interface, without the need for low-level parser programming (pCOS is short for PDFlib Comprehensive Object Syntax).

With PDFlib pCOS you can extract a variety of interesting items from PDF documents. The following list is not exhaustive, but mentions some of the more important uses:

- ▶ general information: linearized PDF, tagged PDF, encryption details and permission settings, number of pages and fonts
- ▶ document info entries and XMP metadata
- ▶ fonts and their name, embedding status, etc.
- ▶ images, color spaces and other resource types
- ▶ target URLs and coordinates of Web links
- ▶ form field data: full field names, contents, position, etc.
- ▶ page size, CropBox, page rotation
- ▶ status of ISO standards PDF/A, PDF/E, PDF/UA, PDF/VT, PDF/X
- ▶ list or extract file attachments
- ▶ enumerate the names of layers (optional content)
- ▶ bookmark, annotation, and comment details
- ▶ digital signature details
- ▶ extract ICC output intent profiles from PDF/X or PDF/A documents
- ▶ find JavaScript on document, page, annotation, or field level

### Value added Tax (VAT)

PDFlib GmbH's invoicing and VAT handling are governed by EU law:

- ▶ Customers from non-EU countries will not be charged VAT.
- ▶ Customers from Germany will be charged 19% VAT (MwSt.).
- ▶ Customers from all other EU countries must provide their VAT identification number to avoid VAT being added to the invoice.

### Support

We offer optional support contracts in combination with a new product license or to renew an existing support contract. An active support contract includes the following advantages (for a detailed description of support benefits refer to the »PDFlib GmbH License Guide«):

- ▶ technical support with short response times
- ▶ all minor (maintenance) and major (functional) updates included
- ▶ early availability of bug fixes
- ▶ maintenance releases and technical support available until the end of a product's lifetime
- ▶ additional licenses can be purchased until the end of the lifetime

Customers without an active support agreement can only use the licensed version, but not any later maintenance updates. This differs from earlier versions where we offered maintenance updates on a voluntary basis.

The support fee is 20% of the license fee per year.

Support contracts can optionally be renewed automatically every 12 months until the support is expressly terminated by the customer. In order to terminate a support agreement with automatic renewal please inform us one month before the support expires.

### Scope of a License

One license covers a single computer running on the selected operating system platform. Development licenses for machines which are not used for production purposes and run under the same operating system are free with each purchase. Redundant (backup) machines do not require a separate license, provided they are never used concurrently with the actual production machines. Groups of load-balancing servers require a license for every server in the group. A license covers all virtual machines (VMs) and logical partitions (LPARs) on a computer.

### Operating System Platform

Supplying the name of the target operating system platform is a strict requirement since the license is bound to a specific platform. Refer to the corresponding system requirements document for deployment details. The license is valid for all supported language bindings (programming languages) on the selected platform.

### Volume Discounts

Volume discounts are available for multiple licenses of the same product according to the table below, provided all licenses are ordered with a single combined order. Please contact us for larger numbers of licenses.

### Major Updates

A major update changes an older license to a license for a newer major version on the same platform, thereby invalidating the old license. A valid license key must be supplied with each update order. Licenses for pCOS 3 can be updated to pCOS 4 at a reduced license fee. Each license entitles to an update to a version 4 license.

Customers without a support contract can add support with a major update. In this case the support fee is based on the full license fee of the product (not the update fee).

### Minor Updates

A minor update changes a license for an older maintenance release to a license for a newer maintenance release (minor version) on the same platform. The fee for minor updates is 20% of the list price of the target product.

### Premium Licenses

In addition to machine-based licenses PDFlib GmbH offers Premium licenses with extended rights, such as site licenses, integration licenses, and source code licenses. Premium licenses are available at a fixed license fee and do not require any additional royalties.
